Mustafa Kemal ATATURK was born in Salonica in 1881. His mother was Zübeyde Hanım and his father was Ali Rıza Efendi. His father died in 1888. He started Military High School in 1893 and his maths teacher added 'Kemal' to his name. In 1902, he graduated from Military Academy.

He went to Samsun in 19th May, 1919 and started the Independence War. He rescued the country and became the first president of Turkey.

Grand National Assembly of Turkey gave the surname Atatürk to Mustafa Kemal in 1934.

He died in 1938 in Dolmabahçe Palace. He was an extraordinary and a brilliant leader. He wrote 9 books and read 3997 books.
