1. Look at the poster below and write down the correct name of the place.



Ephesus is an ancient city located in Selçuk, İzmir, Türkiye. It is famous for its remarkable ruins, including the Library of Celsus, the Great Theatre, and the Temple of Artemis. The temple was also one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Ephesus was once a major city in the Roman Empire, and visitors can see many well-preserved ancient structures such as the Terrace Houses and ancient roads. The best time to visit is during the spring or autumn, when the weather is ideal for exploring.



Göbeklitepe is located in Şanlıurfa, Türkiye, and it is the world's oldest known temple site. Unlike Ephesus, it was not a city but a religious site. Göbeklitepe features massive stone pillars with animal carvings and offers important insights into prehistoric life. Excavations are still ongoing at the site. The best time to visit is during the spring or autumn, when the weather is not too hot.
